ORDINANCE (4)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO UPDATE THE MAXIMUM AUTHORIZED RATE OF MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE USE OF PRIVATELY-OWNED MOTOR VEHICLES ON OFFICIAL BOONE COUNTY BUSINESS TO REFLECT THE STATE OF ARKANSAS' MILEAGE RATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BOONE COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Boone County supersedes the previous mileage rate ordinance that is on file in the County Clerk's Office, and from this point on shall abide by the State of Arkansas' maximum authorized rate of mileage reimbursement for the use of privately-owned motor vehicles on official county business. The State of Arkansas' Office of Accounting will continue to monitor average gasoline prices and the reimbursement rate will be re-evaluated when average gasoline prices decline. Boone County will reflect these changes as they are made at the State level.

Section 2. If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections of the Ordinance, and to such end the provisions and sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.


Section 3. This Ordinance herein enacted is therefore effective immediately.

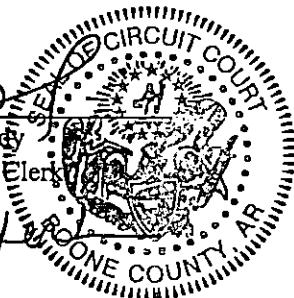
